Creating and Maintaining a

Culture of Integrity in Your Department

Course Description: Regardless of the size of your department, each has an ethical "culture". The Chaplain can play a major role in the overall integrity of the department's personnel, and how the community views its police service. This course is designed to help you assess the current ethical culture, examine common pitfalls and establish an environment of honesty, integrity and accountability. This course is recommended if your department is suffering from low morale, or has experienced increasing numbers of disciplinary actions resulting from character violations.

Advanced Track—cont.

Instructor Chaplain Jim Gunnels has been a law enforcement professional for the past 27 years and is currently a Senior Special Agent and Chaplain with the US Department of Homeland Security. He is a certified ethics and crisis intervention instructor, and frequently serves as a guest instructor at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center.

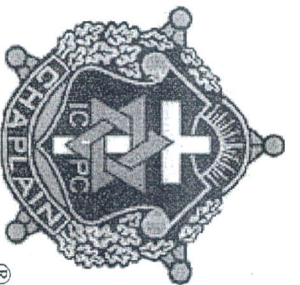
